NOTIFICATION

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that as per the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) will be conducting National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test-II (NEET-II), 2016 on 24th July, 2016. For NEET-II, Srinagar was also made the centre city.

As presently curfew is imposed in Srinagar, State Government is providing all necessary support to conduct the NEET-II in Srinagar to the CBSE and to the candidates. As per their advice, the current status of the centres is as follows:

Following is intimated to the candidates:

1. The admit card issued by the CBSE will be considered as curfew passes as agreed by the State Government.
2. CBSE is sending SMS and e-mails to the candidates about the change of their centres. Also, Press Release is given to disseminate abovesaid information to the candidates. Notification has been issued and uploaded on website.
3. State Government is also disseminating information at their own level.
4. The printed copy of the admit card will be made available to the candidates from 23rd July, 2016 at their new allotted centre in Srinagar. Also, arrangement of photographer is being made to take their postcard and passport size photograph which is a mandatory condition for this examination. Candidates will be photographed without charging any money.
5. For any assistance, candidate may contact the local administration.
6. Candidates are required to make necessary arrangement so that they may be able to reach at their new allotted centre on time on the day of NEET-II examination, i.e., 24th July, 2016. It is also informed that last reporting time at the centre is 09.30 a.m.

All the candidates and parents are requested to note the same and make necessary arrangement to report at the allotted centre on time.
