NOTIFICATION

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that as per the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) will be conducting National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test-II (NEET-II), 2016 on 24th July, 2016. For NEET-II, Srinagar was also made the centre city.

As presently, curfew is imposed in Srinagar, and out of 1740 candidates opted Srinagar as Centre, 1681 candidates have given Jammu as 2nd choice and remaining as third choice. In view of the choices given by candidates, curfew in Srinagar, discussion with the State Administration and schedule fixed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for NEET-II, CBSE has decided to shift the centres to Jammu as per following details:

Following is intimated to the candidates:

1. The admit card issued by the CBSE will be considered as curfew passes as agreed by the State Administration.
2. State Administration has been provided the details of all 1740 candidates.
3. CBSE is sending SMS and e-mails to the candidates about the change of their centre from Srinagar to Jammu. Also, Press Release is given to disseminate abovesaid information to the candidates. Notification has been issued and uploaded on website.
4. The printed copy of the admit card will be made available to the candidates from 23rd July, 2016 at their new allotted centre in Jammu. Also, arrangement of photographer has been made to take their postcard and passport size photograph which is a mandatory condition for this examination. Candidates will be photographed without charging any money.
5. Candidates are required to ensure their availability in the Jammu city in such a manner that they should report at the centre latest by 09.30 a.m. on 24th July, 2016.

All the candidates and parents are requested to note the same and make necessary arrangement to report at the new centre on time.
